-Utility bills will be sent quarterly in January, April, July and October.

-Charges included may include charges for water, meter charge and sewer charges.

-Water & Sewer Residential Bill amount will depend upon usage. The residential bill for a family using 10,000 gallons of water a quarter would be approximately \$210. **-Example:** quarterly meter charge \$17.10, plus 10 x \$4.75 water usage (\$47.50), plus sewer rates \$47.93/month x 3 (\$143.79) = \$208.39.

-Electric service is provided by Xcel Energy. Please contact them (800-895-4999) regarding your electric service.

-Natural Gas service is provided by We Energies. Please contact them (800-242-9137) regarding your natural gas service.

-Refuse & Recycling is contracted by Waterman Sanitation (715-268-6471). Pick-up in the Village is every Friday. Pick-up will happen all Holidays except Christmas. Contact Waterman Sanitation regarding any other refuse & recycling questions you may have.

-Water & Sewer application must be completed by the new owner, occupant or agent. This is available at the Village Hall or on the Village website. **-Payments** can be made in person at 207 Bridge Avenue (drop box in front of building) or by mail: P.O. Box 13, Star Prairie, WI 54026. The

Village can only take checks or cash at this time. If you give your email to the Village, we can send your Water & Sewer bills to you via email.

-Voter Registration is required for all residents in the Village of Star Prairie before you can vote in an election. You will need to have a valid ID that shows your name and current address. More information on our website under *Election Information* tab.

-Winter Parking Prohibited applies to all Village streets and roadways for snow removal during the time period from 12:00 am on November 1 through and 11:59 pm the following March 31. No vehicle shall be parked on any portion of any Village Street or roadway between the hours of 10:00 pm and 6:00 am the following day. The exception to this is the 100 block through the 300 block of Main Street where parking is prohibited from 2:30 am until 6:00 am.

-Building Permits are required for new construction, additions, remodeling, moving structures and demolition. Building permits are issued by Brian Wert Inspection Agency, Inc., 715-386-5410. To obtain a building permit, complete an application available at the Village website or Village Office. Return it to the Village

Office along with a site plan and site layout for consideration.

-Street Numbers shall be affixed to each principal building in the Village by the owner, occupant or agent in charge of the premises. The numbers shall be of contrasting color with the structure and not less than 2.5 inches high on a background of not less than 3 inches. Script-style numbers shall not be used as the primary numbering for a parcel. Each required number shall be on the primary building or on a post in such a location that it may be easily and readily seen by a person on the public street, alley or highway upon which the building abuts.

-All dogs are required to be licensed in the Village. Dog licenses are available at the Village Hall, 207 Bridge Avenue. You will need to provide a copy of current rabies vaccination certificate.

-Community Center & Parks are available for rent. Check your date on our calendar at the Village Hall or on the Village website. Rental forms are available at the Hall and on the website.
